Purposes which the personal data are to be processed for and the legal basis for this

Categories of personal data that are processed and the sources they originate from

The Maecenata Foundation processes the name as well as the contact details, such as the (email) address, for sending the newsletter. The data is directly gathered from the person registered.

Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

The Maecenata Foundation transfers the personal data only to those bodies that the organisation must transfer them to on the basis of statutory provisions.

Processes used by the Maecenata Foundation may also receive data for the aforementioned purposes. These are organisations in the fields of IT services, logistics, printing services and telecommunications.

Intention of the controller to transfer the personal data to a third country or to an international organisation

This intention does not exist.

Duration for which the personal data will be stored or, if this is not possible, criteria for determining the duration of data storage

The Maecenata Foundation stores personal data for the duration of the consent granted. After this consent is revoked or ceases to be granted, the personal data will no longer be stored.
